Airports and Aviation

Vietnam has 35 airports, of which about 10 will be upgraded or expanded within the next few years under a recently approved plan. Under the plan, the central region of Vietnam will have two additional international airports of Can Ranh and Chu Lai besides existing international ones at Danang and Phu Bai.

Central Vietnam will develop into a regional trade centre between the Mekong River region and Asia-Pacific. Meanwhile, southern Vietnam will be home to four international airports of Tan Son Nhat, Can Tho, Phu Quoc and Long Thanh. Other non-international airports are to be provided with better equipment and service facilities. Vietnam airlines plan to increase its fleet of aircraft from 50 today to 104 by 2015.

Danish companies have good opportunities to get into this emerging market, or consolidate its position if already present. Danish companies have in general a good reputation in many ASEAN countries, and are well-known for its sustainable and reliable solutions.

Programme

The programme for the Danish companies within airports and aviation will be a seminar focusing on Danish airport solutions, including a presentation of the companies. The seminar will have participation from the Danish royal family. The seminar will be followed by a business lunch. In the afternoon there will be arranged b2b meetings for all participating companies.

We will invite the following groups from Vietnamese side to the seminar: representatives from ministries, airport authorities, private and public companies within target sectors of the participating Danish companies. There will also be a strong focus on inviting airlines.

Further to the seminar programme there will be arranged site visits to Hanoi Airport and HCMC Airport, incl. introduction to the investment plans, a guided tour in the airport, and a roundtable meeting with a project manager.

The complete programme will be held in both Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City.
